## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

For best results, read through all the instructions first before you start.

- What you are going to need: Garage Carpet, glue, trowel, knife provided in the kit, plus also a straight edge & tape measure.
- Prepare the area; sweep & vacuum the garage to start with a clean surface.
- Unroll carpet and lay out flat, may need to let it acclimatise so it isn't so rippled and easier to work with.
- Measure the garage floor area. The carpet rolls are 2m wide x 6m-6.5m in lenth. Position the rolls in place on the floor, making sure they overlap by 50mm.
- 5. Roll up carpet to expose half the floor for gluing.
- Spread glue evenly using the trowel provided (insure spread evenly for best result). Wait 20mins for glue to become tacty.
- 7. Unroll the carpet back onto the glued area and press the carpet down to the ground. Leave it for 30min.
- While you are waiting you can double cut on the 50mm overlap join using a straight edge and knife. Pull the offcuts off both pieces of carpet to make the perfect join.
- 9. Trim the carpet down to fit around the outside wall and garage door edges.
- After 30 min of leaving the glued carpet, press it again to get rid of any air bubles/ ripples.
- Repeat steps 5 10 for the other half of the carpet.

Now the Garage Carpet installation is complete!
